



Triton Swimming is seeking an enthusiastic and passionate Assistant Coach to join our coaching team for the 2026-2027 season. Based in Beaumont and Leduc, Alberta, Triton is committed to promoting the sport of competitive swimming and delivering high-quality competitive programming for athletes aged 7 – 17, and of various skill levels.

This is an opportunity to play a central role in the continued growth and development of our competitive and junior competitive programs. Working alongside our Head Coach, the successful candidate will help foster a positive, development-focused, and supportive environment that encourages athletes to reach their full potential both in and out of the pool.

Responsibilities Include:

- Planning and delivering age and skill-appropriate practices aligned with Swimming Canada's Athlete Development Matrix to support Appropriate Athlete Development
- Representing the club at swim meets, team events, and coaches' meetings as required
- Working collaboratively with the Head Coach to assess swimmer progress and provide input on athlete development and group placement
- Providing technical instruction and individualized feedback to swimmers during practices and competitions
- Creating a safe, inclusive, and engaging learning environment that encourages athlete confidence, teamwork, and enjoyment of the sport
- Communicating effectively with athletes, parents, volunteers, and coaching staff
- Participating in ongoing coach education and maintaining all required certifications
- Performing other coaching and administrative duties, as assigned by the Head Coach

Qualifications:

- Current NCCP certification Level 1 (Swimming 101) or higher, or a willingness to complete this training (paid for by the club)
- Knowledge of, and commitment to, the Alberta Safe Sport Initiative
- A Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector is required
- Experience coaching in a competitive swimming environment, along with a solid understanding of stroke technique, skill development, and swimming mechanics, is considered an asset
- Strong communication and organizational skills

This is a part-time position with a start date of September 2026. Specific hours will be determined based on group assignment and coach availability. However, there is an opportunity to coach up to 6 days per week (mornings/evenings and weekends), as well as coach at swim meets throughout the season.

Compensation will be commensurate with experience and certification.
